## Young in Hollywood

It's hard to be an actor, and it's even harder to be a young actor in Hollywood. We talked to Sarah Hinchcliff, 23.

# Hollywood must be a difficult place to start acting. Why did you decide to go there?

I was always interested in Los Angeles. I guess because I come from a small town in California, the idea of a big city was very exciting to me. I've loved acting since I was in school, and I knew that I wanted to do that with my life. And I wanted to stay in California, so Hollywood was the place to go.

## You went to acting school in Hollywood. What was that like?

It was hard work, but it was amazing. I was so busy all the time – learning new songs, new scenes, and acting every single day. There were no free days. I think the only reason I did well was because I really love acting. A lot of people in my classes couldn't deal with all the work and they left. But it was amazing to know other people who were just as serious about acting as myself. I learned so much. I really miss acting school¹ now because I don't get the chance to act every day any more!

# So now you're finished with acting school and you're living in Hollywood. Has it been hard to find work?

There have been some good times and bad times. I believe in the phrase "dreams don't work unless you do". So I just keep trying. You have to work really hard and not be scared of hearing the word "no".

#### What sort of work have you done so far?

I've had the chance to act in lots of short films, student films and other projects, and I've been in some TV adverts for other countries. At the moment I'm working in a few casting offices that find actors for TV adverts. That's my "day job".



### What are your plans for the future?

I will stay with acting. I can't imagine my life without it. I'd been lucky and got an agent who will represent me, so I hope some doors will open for me. My next plan is to get a role in a TV series.

# What tip would you give to young people who want to do what you're doing?

Don't be afraid. If someone tells you "no", don't think that you're not good enough. Work hard and believe in yourself! You'll hear 20 no's before you get one yes. But that one yes could make the difference!


